Pronouns

Pronouns are words that are used in place of nouns.

For example- Maria is in the park. She is playing.

The park is big. It has many trees.

Pronouns include I , me, we, us, you, he, him, she, her, it, they, them, mine, ours, yours, his, hers and theirs.

| I, me, we, us | you | he, him, she, her, they, them, it |

***Reflexive pronouns** – These pronouns refer back to the subject. In other words, these pronouns refer to the doer of the action like myself, ourselves, yourself, yourselves, himself, herself, itself and themselves.

For example- Kriti made herself a promise.

The pronoun 'herself' refers back to Kriti who is the subject or the doer of the action.
