Common noun- A name given in common to a person, place, animal or object is known as a common noun. For example- bird, fan, river etc.

Proper noun- The particular names of people, places or things are called proper nouns. Proper nouns always begin with a capital letter.

* Proper nouns include names of persons, cities, places, rivers, mountains, months, festivals, days of the week, historical places etc.
For example – Madhav, Nagpur, Holi, December.
