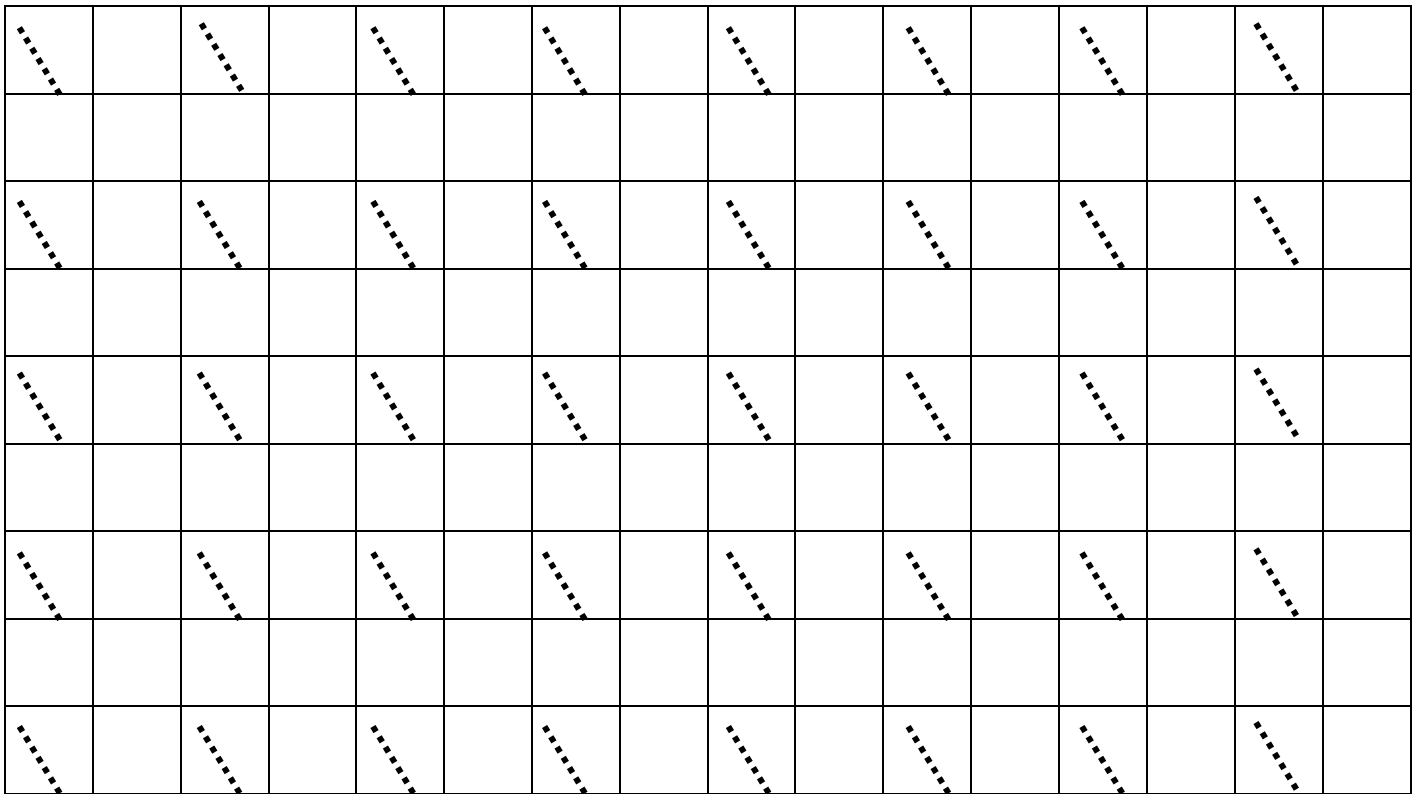

Firstly try to do the homework on your own and then take help of the answer key given to check your work.

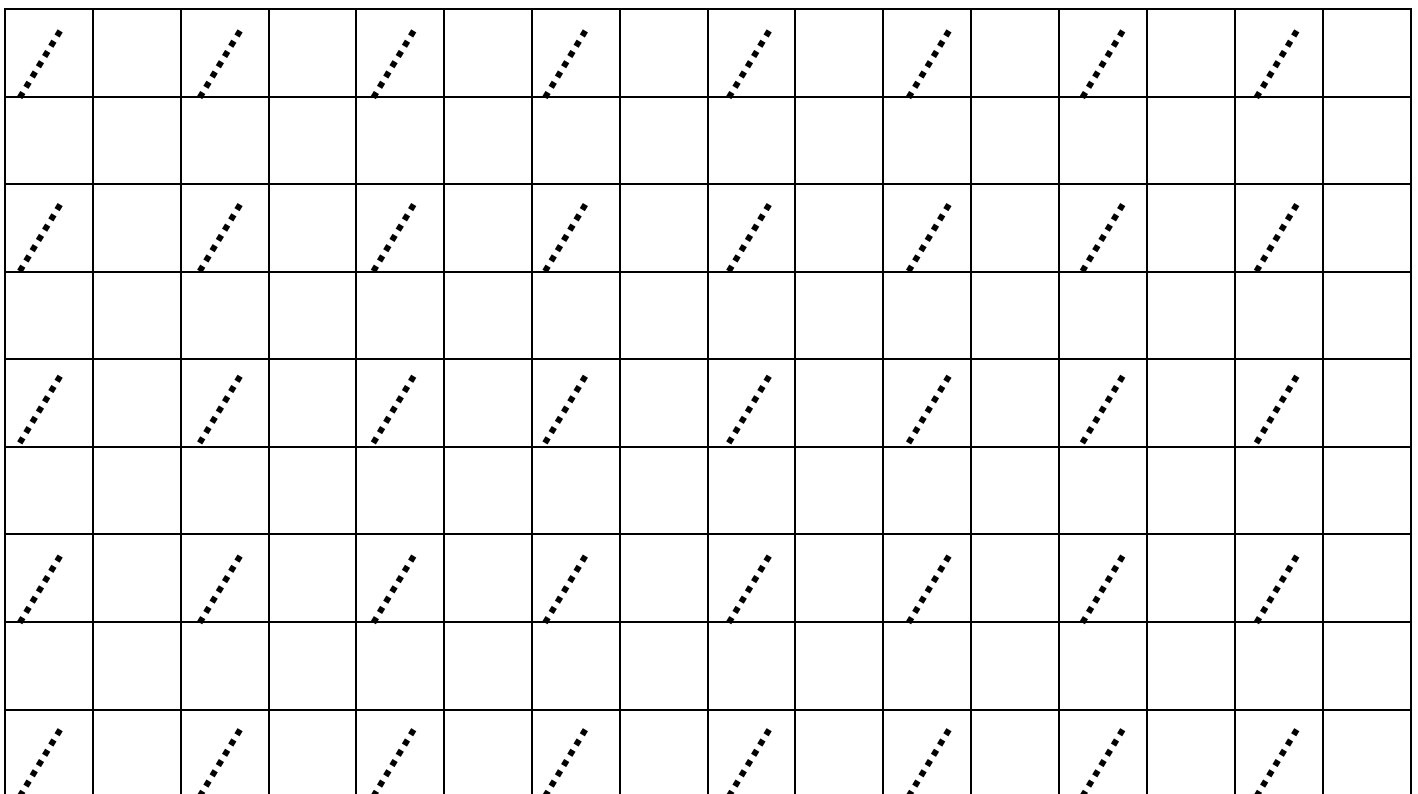
