Chapter 2 - A Word

A **word** is a letter or a combination of letters that express a meaning.

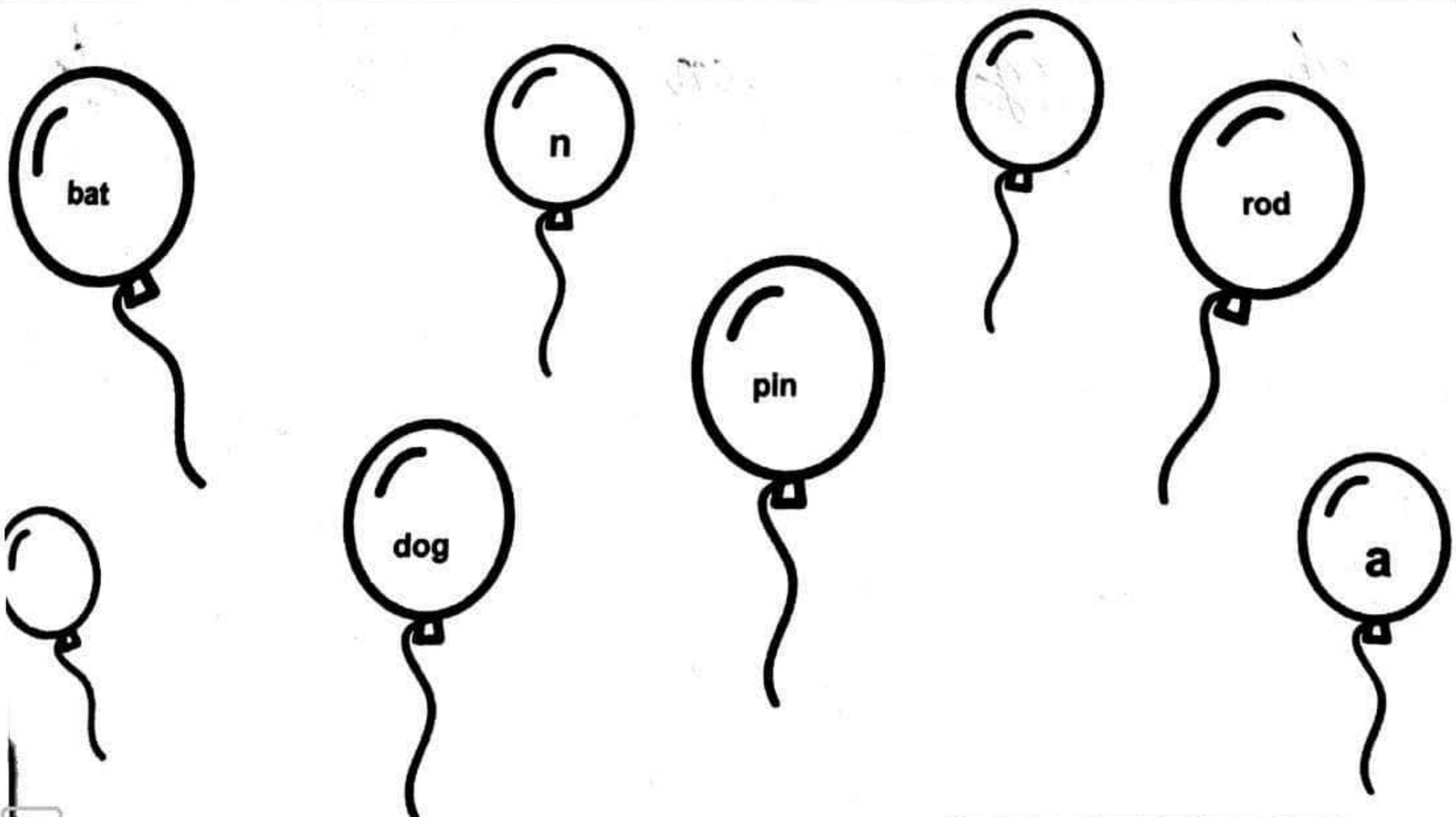
➤ For Example – **l, a, cat, pen, lip, pot, hut** etc.

Each letter of the alphabet represents a particular sound.

We join the sounds of individual letters together to read a **word**.

- We will begin from **VC (Vowel – Consonant)** words like **at, eb, id, of, un** etc.
- Next step would be **CV (Consonant – Vowel)** words like **to, so, me, no** etc.
- Later comes the introduction of **CVC (Consonant – Vowel – Consonant)** words / **Short Sound** words like, **cat, bed, fig, boy, mud** etc.
